Day 01 :- NJP Railway /IXB Airport-Gangtok.....

Meal:- Dinner

Meet & Greet on Arrival at NJP Railway/IXB Airport & Transfer to Gangtok(5,500ft.) . On Arrival Check in Hotel & Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight Stay at Gangtok. Gangtok is the capital of the mountainous northern Indian state of Sikkim. Established as a Buddhist pilgrimage site in the 1840s, the city became capital of an independent monarchy after British rule ended, but joined India in 1975. Today, it remains a Tibetan Buddhist center and a base for hikers organizing permits and transport for treks through Sikkim's Himalayan mountain ranges.

Day 02 :- Excursion to Tsomgo Lake (Nathula Pass-Extra/It is Closed on Monday)

Meal:- Breakfast & Dinner

Tsomgo Lake, also known as Tsongmo Lake or Changgu Lake, is a glacial lake in Changu in the Gangtok district of the Indian state of Sikkim, some 40 kilometres from the capital Gangtok. Located at an elevation of 3,753 m, the lake remains frozen during the winter season.

Day 03 :- Gangtok to Pelling

Meal:- Breakfast & Dinner Pelling is a small town in the northeastern Indian state of Sikkim, at the foothills of Mount Khangchendzonga. The late-17th-century Buddhist Sanga Choling Monastery has mountain views. Pemayangtse Monastery features wall paintings, sculptures and a gold-plated statue of Guru Padsambhava. Overlooking a valley, the 17th-century Rabdentse Palace, now in ruins, still has evidence of the king's bedroom and kitchen. Sightseeing :- Skywalk● Khangchendzonga Waterfalls● Rabdentse Ruins●

Day 04 :- Pelling Sightseeing to Darjeeling

Meal:- Breakfast & Dinner Darjeeling is a town in India's West Bengal state, in the Himalayan foothills. Once a summer resort for the British Raj elite, it remains the terminus of the narrow-gauge Darjeeling Himalayan Railway, or "Toy Train," completed in 1881. It's famed for the distinctive black tea grown on plantations that dot its surrounding slopes. Its backdrop is Mt. Kanchenjunga, among the world's highest peaks. Sightseeing of the Day :- 1. Pemayangtse Monastery 2. Kecheopalri Lake Day
